

NAPA TRUCK SERVICE CENTER "OVER THE ROAD" NATIONWIDE LIMITED WARRANTY

WHO MAKES THIS WARRANTY

This limited warranty is extended only to you, the original purchaser, and not to anyone who may purchase your vehicle from you during the term of the warranty. This limited warranty is made by the Independent Repair Facility ("Dealer") who is so named on the original repair order, and whom performed the service/repairs on your vehicle. This warranty will be honored by any NAPA Truck Service Center Dealer participating in this program, or any other authorized repair facility anywhere in the United States. This warranty is not a warranty by National Automotive Parts Association (NAPA), its employees, jobbers, member companies, or the administrator, Sonsio, Inc., its affiliates, subsidiaries or any of their employees, or member companies. In addition, Sonsio, Inc. serves as the administrator only.

WHAT IS COVERED BY THE WARRANTY

This warranty covers the following types of repairs and services:

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| A. Air Conditioning, heating and climate control systems. | G. Brake system. |
| B. Engine cooling systems. | H. Starting and Charging systems. |
| C. Engine performance, drivability services and repairs. | I. Electrical systems. |
| D. Emission control system. | J. Exhaust system. |
| E. Fuel systems. | K. Ignition System |
| F. Electronic engine management system and other on-board computer systems, (engine, body, brake and suspension computers), Cruise control systems. | L. Steering/suspension systems, wheel bearings, U-joints, and drive shafts. |
| | M. Other minor repairs. |

The Independent Repair Facility warrants that the above repairs and services performed at their location will be **free from defects in materials and workmanship for 45 days** measured from the date of the first repair shown on the original repair order. This warranty is conditioned on the vehicle being subjected only to normal use, and receiving reasonable and necessary maintenance during the warranty period. **Warranty repair costs shall in no case exceed the costs of the original related repair or service.** If there is a defect in either materials or workmanship within the warranty period, the Independent Repair Facility shall have the option to either perform remedial service work at no charge to you, replace the defective warranted part(s) without charge to you, or refund to you the entire charge for the warranted repairs, minus any previous refunds or credits.

This warranty will cover medium/heavy duty trucks with a load capacity of 1 tons or greater designed or built for highway use. It specifically excludes medium/heavy duty trucks designed and built for off road service or use.

WHERE YOU CAN OBTAIN WARRANTY SERVICE

Whenever possible you should return your vehicle to the NAPA Truck Service Center location where the warranted service was performed and present your copy of the repair order to the Dealer. If your vehicle is inoperable, or it would be impractical to return to the original NAPA Truck Service Center location you may have another NAPA Truck Service Center location perform the warranty repairs. If you are not aware of a participating NAPA Truck Service Center location in your area, then **you must call the warranty administrator, at (888) 925-5428**, from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Monday through Friday (Eastern Time) and 8:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Saturday (Eastern Time), excluding holidays. The Administrator will direct you to the nearest participating NAPA Truck Service Center. If there are no NAPA Truck Service Center locations in your area, the administrator will direct you to a non-NAPA Dealer location.

WHAT YOU MUST DO TO OBTAIN WARRANTY SERVICE

You must keep a copy of the original repair order and present it when seeking service under this warranty. If warranty work is performed, you must temporarily surrender possession of the repair order.

If there are no participating locations in your area, you must obtain authorization from the Warranty Administrator prior to any warranty repair work by calling **(888) 925-5428**. If the non-participating Repair Facility location will not accept payment from the Warranty Administrator, you must pay for the warranty service and submit a legible copy of your original repair order and warranty service repair order to the Administrator for review.

WHAT IS NOT COVERED BY THIS WARRANTY

You must pay for any non-warranty service you order to be performed at the same time as the warranty service. This warranty will not apply to your repaired vehicle if it has been damaged by abnormal use, misuse, neglect, accident, alteration or "tampering with" (by other than the Facility or Facility employees). The Facility's employees and/or agents do not have authority to modify the terms of this warranty nor to make any promises in addition to those contained in this warranty. This warranty does not in any way include **INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES** (additional expenses which you may incur as the result of faulty repair or service). Some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitation or exclusion may not apply to you. This warranty gives you specific rights, and you may also have other rights, which vary from state to state.

REPAIRS EXCLUDED FROM WARRANTY

This warranty does not cover repair(s) or replacement(s) except as listed in the section, "What is Covered by this Warranty," even though the Facility may offer other services. Repairs specifically excluded from the Limited Nationwide Warranty include:

- I. ENGINE:
 - A. Any internal repairs or replacement of internal components, or replacement of engine assembly.
- II. TRANSMISSION, TRANSAXLES:
 - A. Automatic – any internal repair or component replacement requiring the removal of the automatic transmission from the vehicle or disassembly of same.
 - B. Manual – any internal repair or component replacement requiring the removal of the transmission from the vehicle or disassembly of same.
- III. DRIVE AXLE/DIFFERENTIAL ASSEMBLY
 - A. Any repair or component replacement requiring the removal of internally lubricated components or replacement of the drive axle/differential assembly.
 1. Ring gear, pinion shaft and related gears
 2. Associated bearing with above
 3. Pinion seal
- IV. BODY, PAINT, MOLDING REPAIR
 - A. Any repair or materials related to body repair work
 - B. Glass related repairs
- V. CLUTCHES: Components or assembly, repair or replacement
- VI. TIRES
